Finished Block Size: 12" x 12"

Supplies Needed:

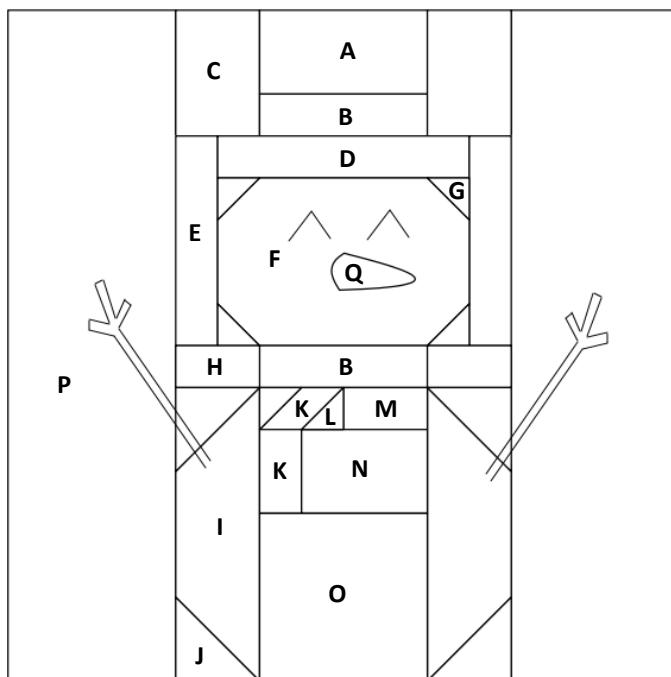
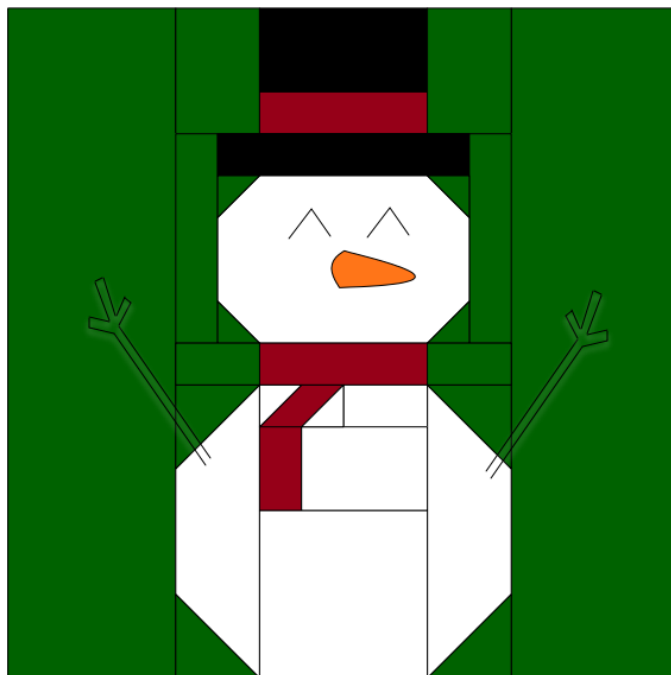
- Fat Quarter or ¼yd of Green fabric
- Fat 8th of White fabric
- Fat 16th each of Black and Red fabric
- Orange Scrap of fabric (2"x3")
- Brown and Black Embroidery Floss
- Embroidery Needle
- Heat N Bond Lite (2"x3")
- Pencil or Erasable Fabric Pen

General Notes:

- All seams are ¼"
- Right Sides Together = RST
- Press seams to either side unless noted.

Cutting Instructions:

	N	1	2" x 2¾"
	O	1	3½" x 3½"
Green	C	2	2" x 2¾"
	E	2	1¼" x 4¼"
	G	4	1¼" x 1¼"
	H	2	1¼" x 2"
	J	4	2" x 2"
	P	2	3½" x 12½"
Orange	Q	1	2" x 3"

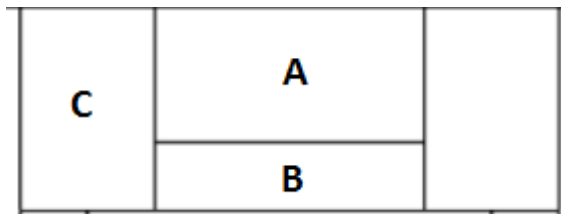


Piecing Instructions

Assemble the snowman together in sections from top to bottom.

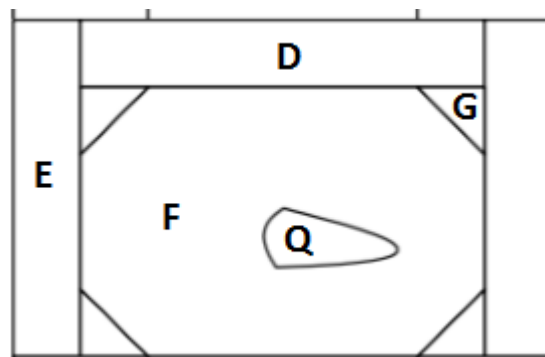
Section 1: The Top of the Hat

- Sew the A piece and the B piece together as shown.
- Then add the two C pieces to the sides.
- Press the seams towards the C pieces.



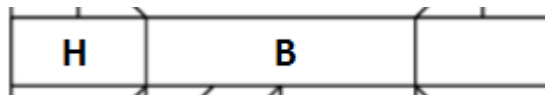
Section 2: The Brow of the Hat and the Face

- Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on all G pieces.
- Place the G piece in the corner of the F piece RST with the edges matching. Sew ON the line. Trim ¼" past the seam. Press the seam to the G Piece.
- Repeat for all 4 corners (F+G piece).
- Add the D piece to the F+G piece.
- Then add the E pieces to the sides.
- OPTION: Applique the Q piece to the face now or wait till the block is complete. See Applique Instructions on the next page



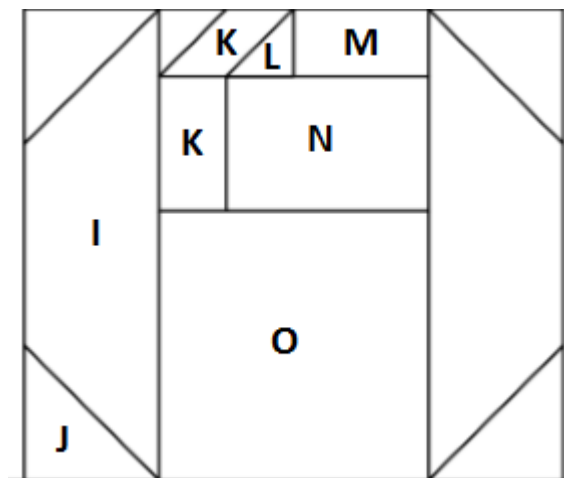
Section 3: The Scarf top

- Sew the H pieces on either side of the B piece as shown. Press seams towards the B piece



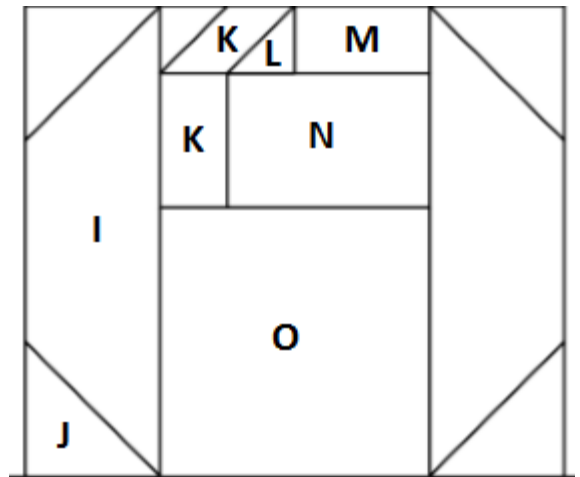
Section 4: The Body

- Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on all L and J pieces.
- With RST, align the edge of the L piece to the edge of the K piece. Sew ON the line. Trim ¼" past the seam. Press the seam to the L Piece.
- Repeat on the other side taking notice of the diagonal direction of the scarf (K+L piece).
- Sew the K+L piece and the M piece together (K+L+M piece).
- Sew the K and N pieces together (K+N piece). Press the seam towards the K piece.
- Sew the K+L+M and the K+N pieces together.
- Then add the O piece. (Center Body)



Section 4: The Body (continued)

- With RST, align the edge of the J piece to the edge of the I piece. Sew ON the line. Trim ¼" past the seam. Press the seam to the J Piece.
- Repeat on the other side taking notice of the diagonal direction of the scarf (J+I piece).
- Make 2 J+I pieces.
- Add the J+I pieces to the Center Body as shown. Press seams towards the J+I pieces.

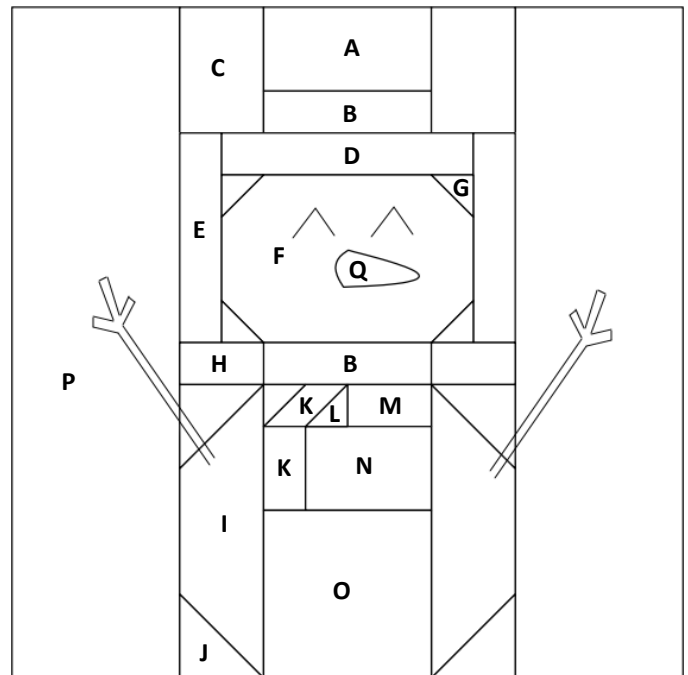


Assembling the Snowman:

- Sew Section 1 to 2 to 3 to 4 to create the snowman.
- Add the P pieces to the sides of the snowman as shown. Press the seams to the P piece.

Finishing the Snowman:

If you had not appliqued the nose yet, do so now. Then, embroider the Eyes (in black) and Arms (in brown) of the Snowman with a backstitch to finish the block.



NOTE: Make sure that the template is print to 100%, use the 1" test block to confirm sizing is correct.

Raw Edge Applique Instructions:

Trace the Nose on to the paper side of the Applique paper (Heat N Bond Lite).

Remove the backing paper and iron onto the orange fabric.

Cut the Nose out on the line.

Remove the top paper and iron onto the block.

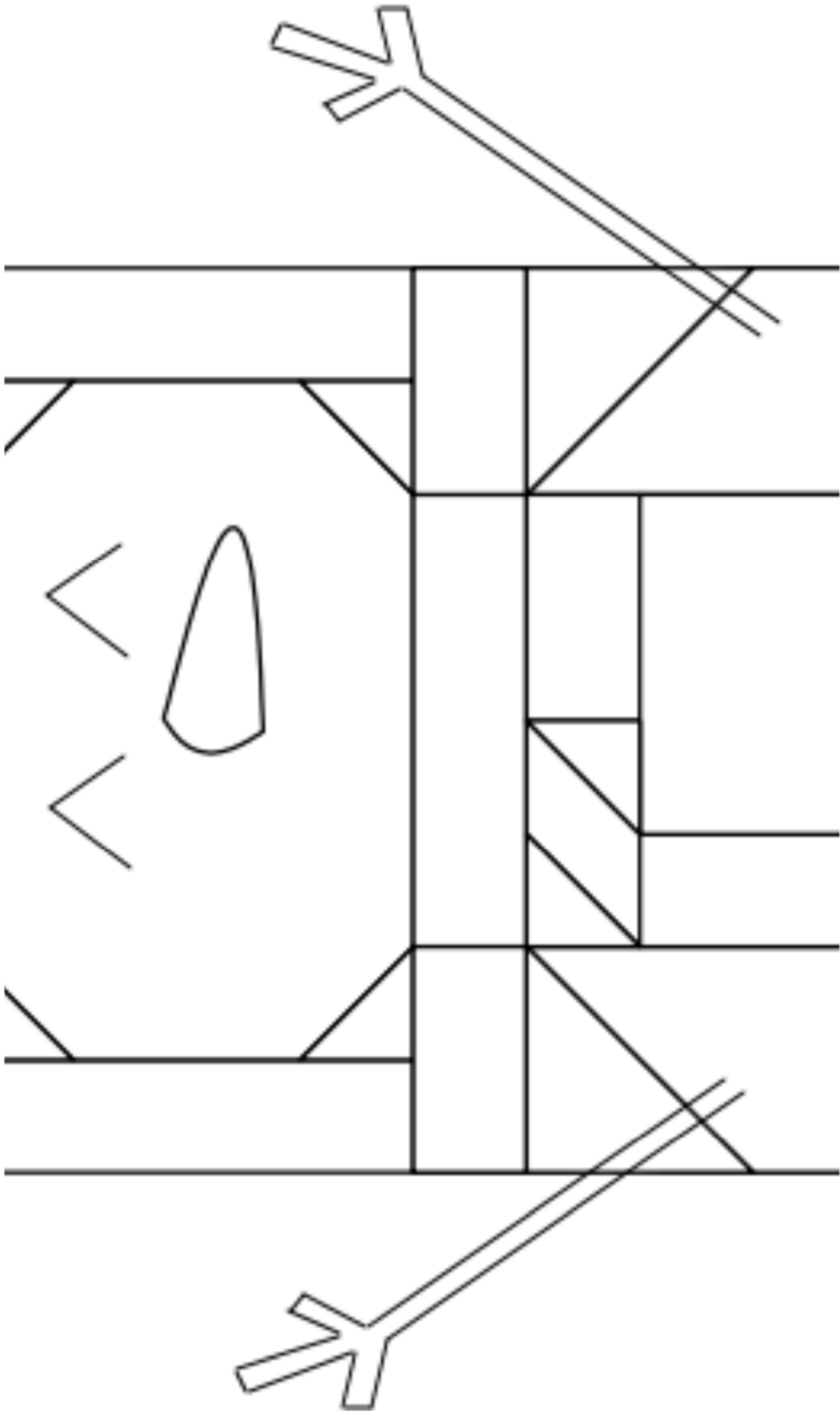
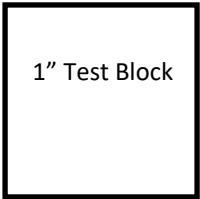
Use a blanket stitch to stitch around the edges of the Nose.

Embroidery Instructions:

Using your pencil or fabric erasable pen, trace the arms and nose onto the block using the piecing lines as reference.
