
Finished Block Size: 12" x 12"

General Notes:

- Read through all instructions prior to starting
- All seams are ¼"
- Right Sides Together = RST


Cutting Instructions:

COLOR	QTY	DIMENSION
A	10	2½" x 2½"
	2	4½" x 4½"
B	6	2½" x 2½"
	6	2½" x 4½"




Quadrant Assembly Instructions:

- Using Four 2½" squares of Fabric A, Three 2½" squares of Fabric B, and One 2½" x 4½" of Fabric B, lay out the quadrant as shown below.
- Sew the rows together, and then sew the quadrant together.
- Make 2.




Quadrant Assembly Instructions Continued:

- Using One 2½" square of Fabric A, One 4½" square of Fabric A, and Two 2½"x4½" of Fabric B, lay out the quadrant as shown below.
- Sew the rows together and then sew the quadrant together.
- Make 2.



Block Assembly:

- Lay the 4 quadrants in the final block layout. Keep in mind the orientation of the quadrants.
- Sew the rows together, and then sew the block together.



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
